God's word in the Bible, and being filled with his Holy Spirit.

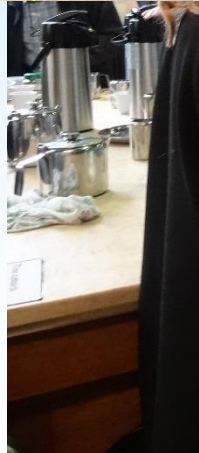

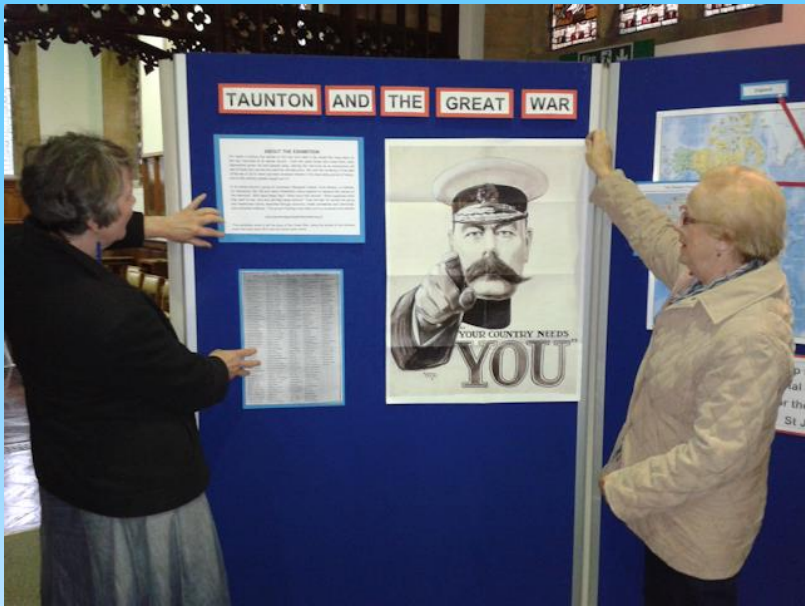
