# **SHARE**

Start by sharing if, when and how you have experienced the Holy Spirit.

# **PRAY**

Holy Spirit we welcome you. As we gather here today much like the disciples did all those years ago we open ourselves up to your teaching and long for more of you Lord.

#### **READ** Acts 1:1-8

In order to prepare for this wonderful gift the disciples are given one instruction 'wait'. How do you find waiting and trusting God's timing? They aren't told how long or even what to expect in any detail. These are Jesus' last words immediately before he ascended. Try and put yourselves in the shoes of those disciples as they waited the next 10 days for the Holy Spirit to come.

# **READ** Acts 2 v1-13

At the start of chapter 2, we read 'When the day of Pentecost had come' – this is not just a date! Luke is telling his readers that the Spirit came when the time had been fulfilled, at the right moment, at the specified time. The believers had not prayed the Spirit down. In his Sovereignty, he had come at the exact moment He had planned.

Jerusalem was packed with pilgrims, from all over the Jewish diaspora, speaking many different languages. They had come to observe *Shavuot*, the Feast of Harvest, of the firstfruits of seed sown in the fields (Exodus 23:16). They did not expect to meet Galileans speaking about God in their native tongue. And so, they asked, "What does this mean?". It meant the real harvest was beginning. By the end of the day around three thousand had joined the new community of believers in Christ (Acts 2:41).
