You might want to read the passage from Ezekiel 37. 1-14

Renew, Restore, Revive - "Re" implies the idea of "again," "once more,"

Renew --> new again, re-start, fresh reset

Restore --> the idea of God given us a new story/identity with the coming of the Holy Spirit Revive --> bring new life, new hope
